



## 2019 IRHA STALLION AUCTION REGULATION

- The auction will take place in sessions of 4 weeks each.
- The first session will start on January, 20th, including all of the stallions that were entered before January, 19th. The second session will start on February, 20<sup>th</sup>, 2019, and participants will be comprised of both the breedings that have not been claimed in the first session, and the new stallions who will have joined in the meantime.
- The auction is open to anybody, all you have to do is to choose a stallion, log in and place a bid.
- For technical reasons, all prices are in euros. US stallions' stud fees will be converted at a fixed rate change of 0,8 (es. \$ 1.000 = € 800).
- The starting bid is the 50% of the stallion's 2019 official stud fee. Increment bid is \$50 per offer. Every time a new competitor places a bid, all other competitors will be notified by e-mail, so that they can place a new bid in their turn.
- Object of the auction is the **breeding fee only**. All additional fees (semen shipping, frozen fee, etc.), will be discussed with – and paid directly to – the stallion's owner/agent.
- Auction winner is the holder of the highest bid at the end of the auction.

- Breeding fee resulting from the auction will have to be paid – with no exceptions – within five days from the auction end.
- At the same time, the winner will have to sign the official stallion's breeding contract for the 2019 season.
- In case the fee is not paid, the breeding will be assigned to the second highest-placing bidder, in interested. If not, it will be offered to the third highest-placing bidder, and so on.

- Donated breedings are property of the Italian Reining Horse Association, with legal headquarters in Parma, Via Stradello Pratospilla, 13, and they cannot – for whatever reason – be claimed back by the stallion's owner. All unassigned breedings will be used by IRHA for the association's activities.
- As a reward for the donation of the breeding, the stallion's owner will receive visibility on the auction's website and on the social networks chosen for the auction's promotion.
